





Quainton Memorial Hall (QMH) has adopted a good neighbour policy. It is intended to reduce any impact from noise resulting from lettings of the Memorial Hall that might otherwise cause a nuisance to people living close to the premises. QMH and neighbours recognise that events involving music may be heard outside the Hall but there is a level at which noise levels become excessive and may be regarded as a nuisance. Not all events have a potential to cause a nuisance, but for the few that do, the following policy will apply:

People who wish to hire the Hall for an event must nominate a person who will be responsible for the activities at the Hall for the whole duration of the event. That person must provide an undertaking to be responsible for controlling the event so that neighbours are not unreasonably affected by the event taking place.
